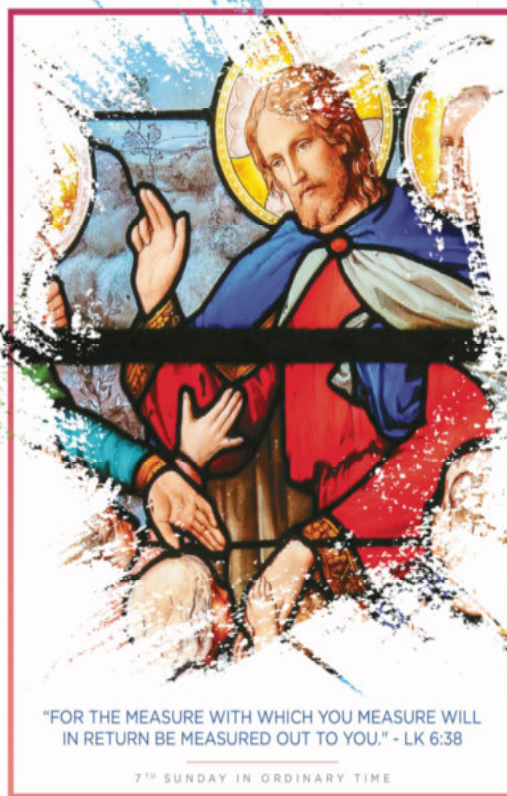

That's a hard nut to crack especially when it comes to loving and forgiving people who do hurtful and violent things.
