Reading the Old Testament can be a hard read. Take a look at the book of Judges. With all its battles and mighty warriors, this book can sometimes feel like reading about comic book



superheroes. We have Deborah, Barak, Gideon, Samuel and so on. However, the first in line of Judges was Othniel. His story is brief and only 4 lines. However there is no drama, no display of prowess, pretty much straightforward.

What we do see is what God did through Othniel; God ask him to rescue the Israelites from the King of Mesopotamia. The Othniel account helps us focus on what is most important- the activity of God! Interesting stories and fascinating people sometimes obscure that. We end up concentrating on those and fail to see what the Lord is doing.

God often uses ordinary people for His extraordinary work. It is His light shining through our lives that glorifies God and draws others to Him. Our limited ability highlights God's limitless power. When others look at our life, it is important that they see God-not us!
