What Kind of Soil Am I?

Every fall, thousands of backyard gardeners haul an enormous harvest to county and state fairs around the country. Forklifts and small cranes are required to lift the largest pumpkins onto the scales. Blue ribbon winners weigh as much as a compact car.



The bar gets higher almost every year – the 1,000-pound mark was first breached around the turn of the millennium; the current world-record pumpkin weighed in at 2,323.7 pounds, grown by a German gardener in 2014. However to grow these large pumpkins, you need to have good soil and nurture them during the growing seasons.

In Matthew chapter 13, Jesus used a parable in which He illustrated different types of soil in response to His Word. Some seeds fell on rocky ground and were eaten by birds. Some seeds grew but were choked out by weeds of temptation in the world. But the seeds that fell on good soil produced a bountiful crop.

Each of us needs to ask “what kind of soil am I?” The Lord plants His seeds in each one of us so we can grow in gifts of the Holy Spirit. May the Spirit of God show us the person, Christ wants us to be, Amen.

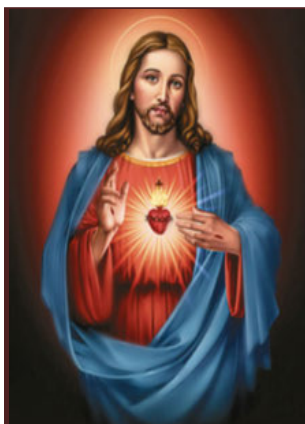

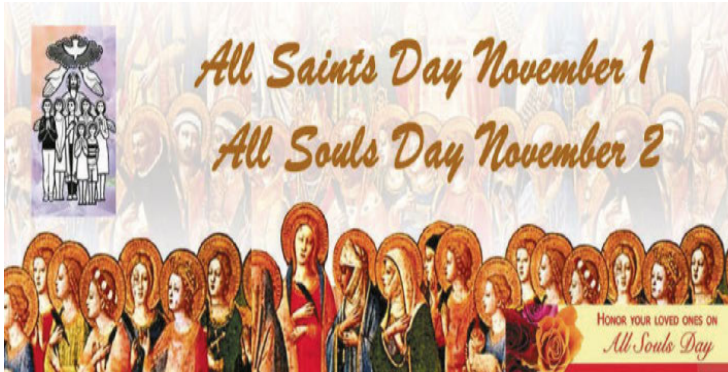

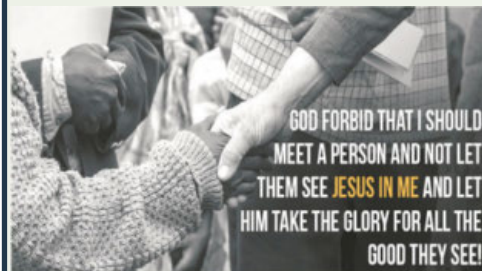
