One Sunday morning a Sunday school teacher asked her 3rd grade students this question; "if Jesus would show up for class today what questions would you ask him?" 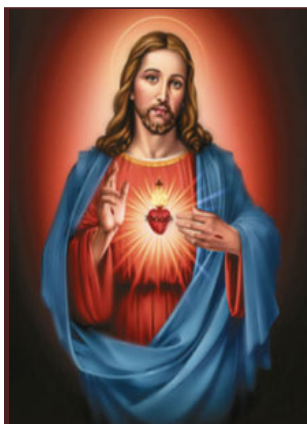

This will be a touching time of remembrance for those who have gone before us. Please remember to light a candle and pray for their souls.

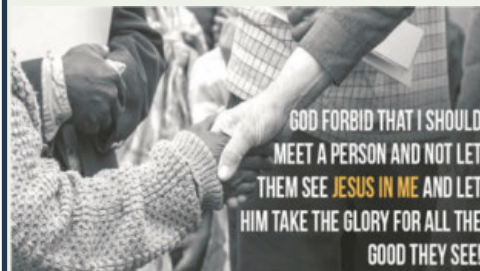
