#### Turn from Judgment to Reflection

Are you willing to look within yourself and examine your motives and feelings? Jesus asked those who gathered to stone the woman caught in adultery, to think about their own sins and if they found they were without sin to cast the first stone. After reflection they all turned away and Jesus was left with alone with the woman. He told her to go and leave her life of sin. (John 8:7-11)

Jesus turned their judgmental hearts by having them examine their own hearts and look at their own sin. While standing in judgment over the woman, they realized they were guilty too and needed to turn away from judgment.

How about you? I know I am sometimes too quick to judge others and should have given them the benefit of the doubt, sought to find out why they acted as they did or faced them with forgiveness in my heart. If I understand Jesus' example, He wants me to look at my own sinfulness and pay attention to setting my own things right with Him.



He wants me reflective, repentant, open and humble not judgmental, close minded, arrogant or self-righteous. Here is a verse to meditate on today as you think reflectively. Psalm 19:14 "May the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart be pleasing in your sight, O LORD, my Rock and my Redeemer."


And if you need a little help, here is a prayer to say;




