When have you been fully alive?

I expect you have probably heard something like this before. Preachers are fond of telling their flock to live in such a way that people see Christ in them. Yet, such expectations often fail, largely because they leave us feeling guilty about our failures. Or, perhaps, we resolve to do better, to put on a happy face, to talk as if we're living the heavenly life today even when heaven seems far, far away. But, before long, we're back to our old, lifeless, ordinary ways.

If you want to live as a person fully alive, I would not suggest that you focus on your failings as a Christian. Nor would I urge you to put on a happy face, denying what's true in your heart. Rather, I would suggest that you and I need to let his grace transform us and inspire us. The more we are captivated by what God has done for us through Christ, the more we will be motivated to live transformed lives.



We should be people who live life to the fullest, enjoying and making use of the gifts that God has given us. 


