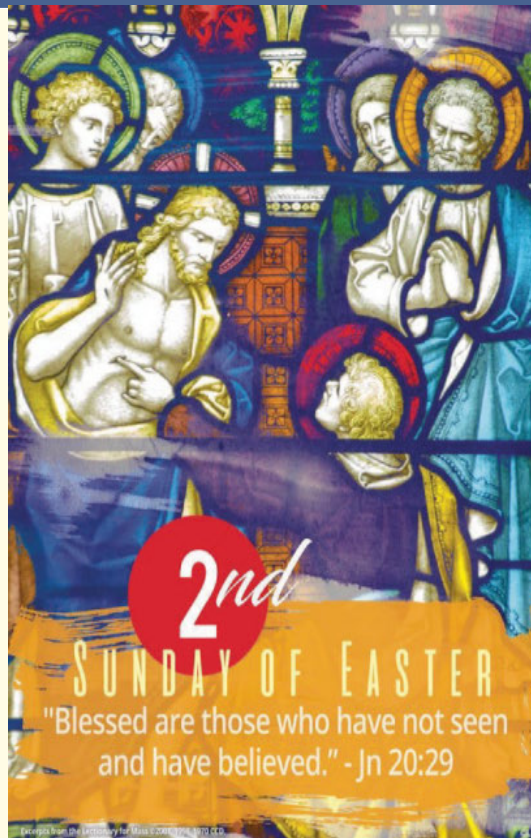

Turning the Other Cheek?

These words of our Lord are so familiar to us. "Turn the other cheek; go the extra mile; give to the one who asks" (Matthew Chapter 5) Our human nature sometimes sees other people as competitors, threats, obstacles, tools before we get to know them. And so we are always ready to defend, to take advantage, to outsmart.

Jesus is inviting us to adopt a different perspective. He wants us to discover the dignity and the worth of other people, regardless of their flaws and sins. He wants us to learn to see others as he sees them—as children of God and saints in the making. When we see others in that way, we discover a new strength in our own hearts. We are able to *choose* how we respond to insults (not every insult deserves a response) and injustices (bear wrongs patiently).

When we look past the brokenness of this world and the ugliness of our fallen nature, we see the face of Christ in our brothers and sisters. This is Christ's invitation. He believes in us so much that he actually invites and prepares us to follow his own example by being a Good Samaritan.

As we learn to do this, to live our relations with other people on the level of the deeper truth of our common human nature (We are made in the image and likeness of God) and our Christian vocation (to love our neighbor as ourselves), we will also learn what it really means to be blessed: "Blessed are the merciful, for they will receive mercy" (Matthew 5:7).

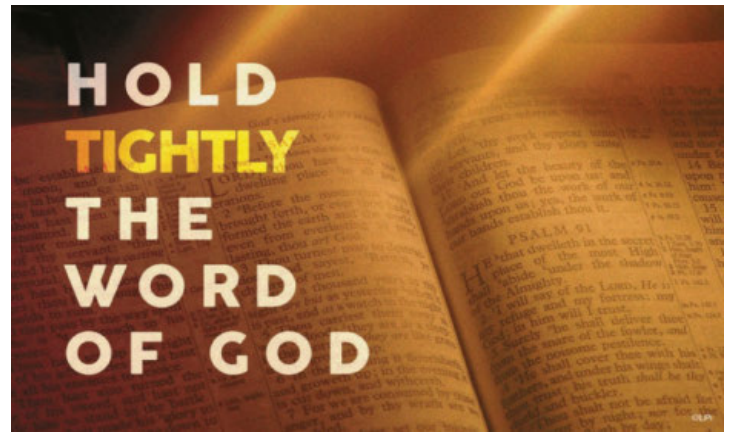
High School Youth Group: Teen Connection & Confirmation Prep:
