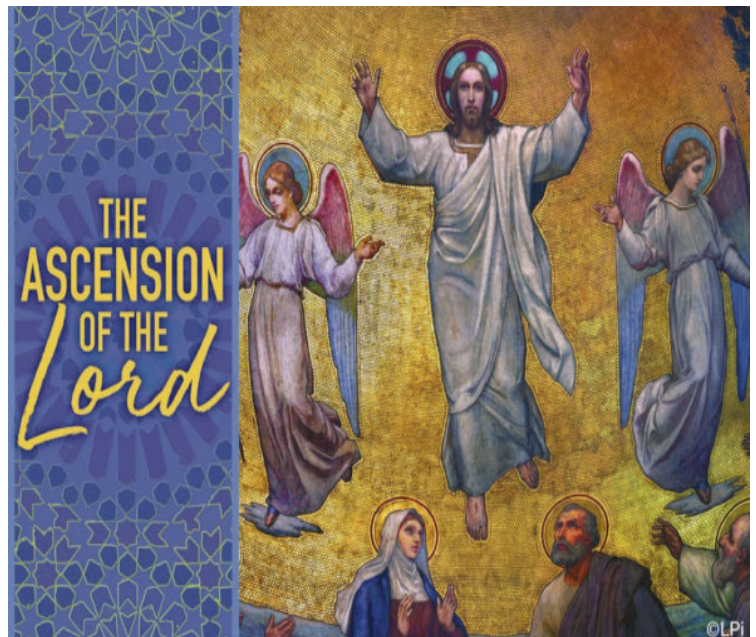

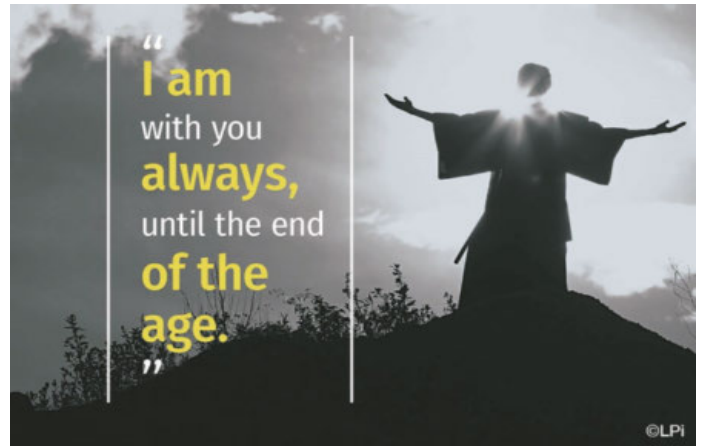


Youth Group: Teen Connection & Confirmation Prep:
