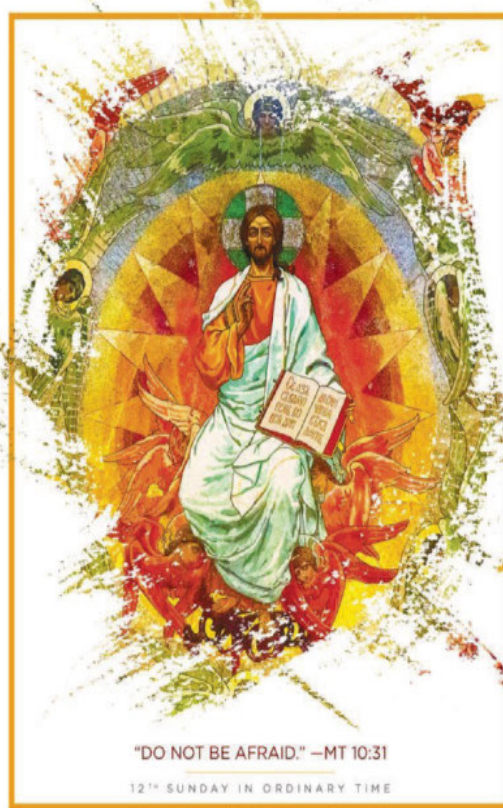

I was recently asked what room and board meant. Room and Board dates back to the 17th Century England. It began as a table with wide boards. One side was used for eating meals the other side for chopping food. In time, other expressions grew for the usage as the word 'board' became associated with food, housing, honesty and authority.

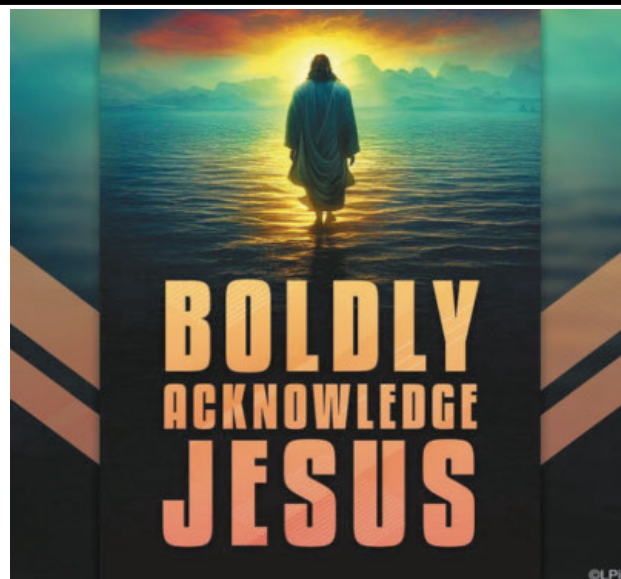
An inn would offer 'room and board' that is, sleeping and eating accommodations. In taverns where customers played cards, they were told to keep their hands 'above board' to make sure they were not cheating. And in the home, the father was given a special chair at the head of the table where he was called 'chairman of the board'.

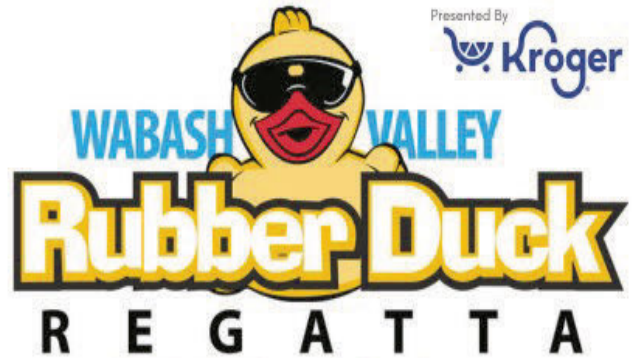

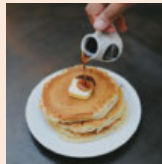
