Constructive Concern

In the last week and a half Cindy and I have packed up our RV and took a trip to Wisconsin, Minnesota and Iowa. During our trip, one of our tires blew out on the RV. I changed the tire, but I worried about not having a spare for fear of another blowout. Therefore, I was not able to enjoy the scenic drive until I got a new tire. I learned the longer I worry about something, the more my fears weighed me down.



Do you struggle to get through the day because you are consumed with worry? If you do, you are not alone. There is an endless supply of things to worry about, both in world affairs and in our personal lives. It can consume us and distract us from living in the moment and from being in tune with God's voice in our lives.

While you wrestle with anxiety-filled thoughts, you are consumed and robbed of the gift to live in the present and it's in the present moment that God does His work—and that's where He intends you to be. When your worry super-imposes the "future" on the "present," it empties today of its strength.

Scripture says that God has not given you the spirit of fear, somebody else has: the devil. He would like nothing more than to distract you from God and who God wants you to be. Recognizing that obsessive worry is a spiritual battle makes all the difference. First, it reminds you that you will not win the war on worry by your own strength. As a Christian, we have Christ. He never worries, and He asks you to bring all your worries to Him.

Thankfully, God has provided a way out of obsessive worry—it is through Jesus. When you turn your worries into prayers, it is not that your worries go away, but they are transformed from "destructive worry" to "constructive concern."

It will take practice, and you might find yourself falling to your knees in prayer many times throughout the day. It will take courage, but in the end, courage is worry, fear, and anxiety that have said its prayers. Amen!

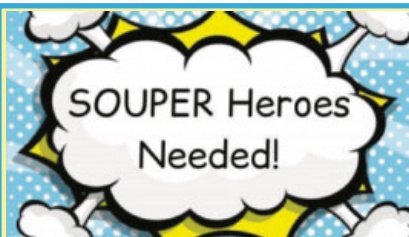

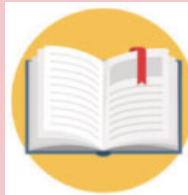
