As Christians we often wonder if God has a specific plan

for our lives, where we will live, what our life's work will be, etc., the question becomes, "How do I know God's plan?" The answer is that you do not know God's plan for our life, at least you don't get to know it in advance. I often say this about our journey through life: out the rearview mirror we can often see how God is



working in our lives, although probably not as much or as clearly as we think – but out the windshield it is all faith!

People usually seek to know God's plan because they have decisions to make, and they don't want to make them badly. When we are seeking direction, as we should, we need to step back from the decision and look at our responsibility to ourselves and all involved. God tells us to obey Him not in the details of our lives but in terms of what obedience to Him demands. And that we should love him with all our hearts, our minds and strength and love our neighbor as ourselves. That is God's plan for your life.

God loves you and has a wonderful plan for your life – but it probably isn't the plan you have in mind, unless you were hoping for difficulty and pain and hardship and toil. What you want is success and comfort and spiritual happiness; what God is aiming for is glory – his and yours – through the growth of your faith and the conforming of your life to Jesus Christ.
