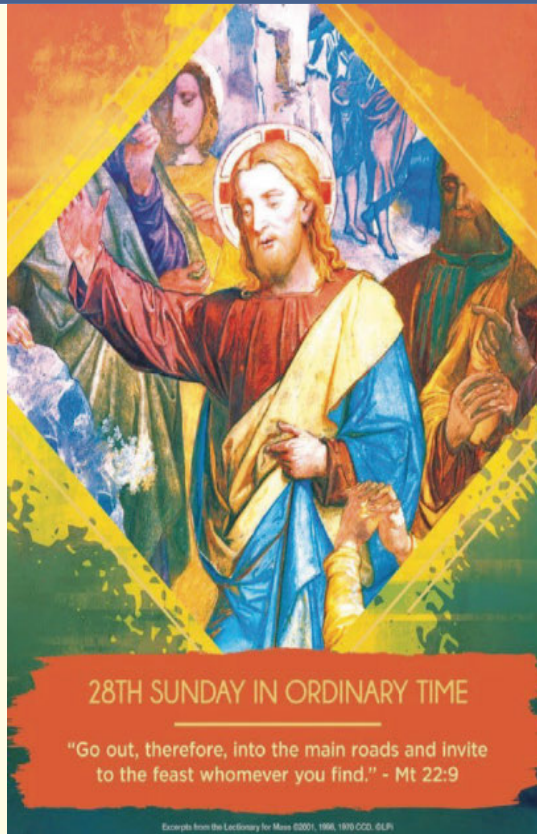

Review the items being recycled to see which can be

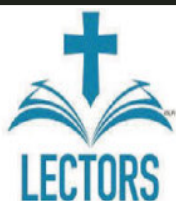
Reduced in numbers or

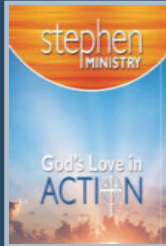

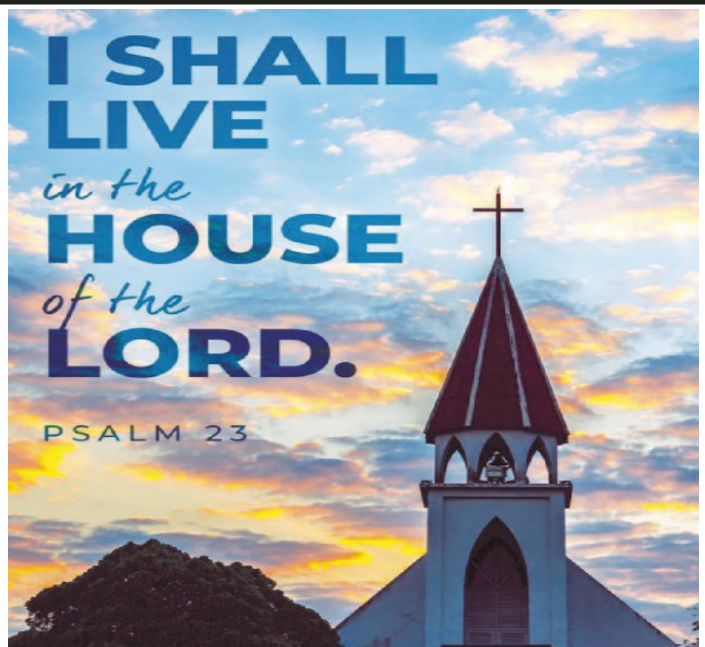

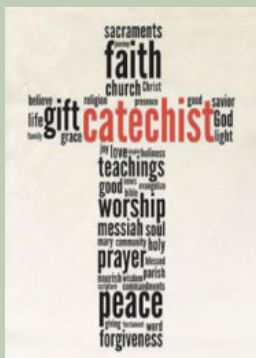
