Our Heart Condition

In Luke chapter 8, Jesus compares the state of a person's heart to the condition of four types of soil in a field. While we usually think about this parable as only relating to a person's initial response to the gospel, it really applies to our whole lives.

Like the seed thrown on the path, there may be some aspect of God's Word in your life that is being trampled or snatched up before it can take root. You either reject the truth or just ignore it long enough that the "birds" come and take it away.

When we neglect God's Word, we start to wither away like the seed thrown on the rocks. As a result, we fail when tempted or tested. Remember that the Christian life is a journey, not a sprint. We need to frequently reflect on the gospel so that our hearts remain encouraged.

If we allow sin to grow in our hearts, it will be like the third soil that will choke out the truth and keep us from growing. We will become overshadowed by the pleasures or concerns of the world. Regardless of what these thorns are in your life, your response to them should be the same: turn away from them and turn to Jesus.



Regardless of whether times are good or bad, we should regularly be asking ourselves, what soil am I in?


