





St. Margaret Mary Retirees Journey with Fr. Dan and me to the Shrine of Christ's Passion St. John's, Indiana Thursday, September 21, 2017

The Shrine of Christ's passion is located at St. John's, Indiana, 35 miles south of Chicago on U.S. Hwy 41. Located on 30 acres this non-denominational shrine consists of a half mile walkway of the last days of Christ. Its construction consists of 3000 yards of concrete, 200 semi loads of boulders, 1000 trees and shrubs, and 40 life size bronze sculptures. The most recent addition to the shrine is a life size depiction of Moses on Mount Sinai, holding the 10 commandments. Visitors can also visit a 10,000 square foot gift shop. Admission is free to the visitors; however, donations are appreciated to maintain the shrine.

Departure will be by Enterprise rental van and cost will be shared by the number of passengers. We will depart from the parish at 8:00 am for the 2 ½ hour drive to St. John's. Stops will be along the way for stretching our legs! You will not want to miss out on this day of prayer and fellowship!
