



Reflections from Deacon Mike Stratman

An Oasis of Hope

A priest, who was trained in trauma and grief counseling, commented that the greatest challenge for people who are hurting is often not the immediate heartache of the loss. Instead, the biggest problem is adjusting to the different kind of life that follows. What once was normal may never be normal again.

So the challenge for those offering help is to assist the sufferers as they establish "a new normal." It may be a new normal that no longer includes robust health, a treasured relationship, or a satisfying job. Or it may be living without a loved one who has been taken in death. The weight of such losses in our lives, forces us to live a different kind of life no matter how unwelcome it may be.

When our "new normal" comes, it's easy to think no one understands how we feel. But that is not true. Part of the reason Jesus came was to experience life among us, resulting in a High Priest who can sympathize with our weaknesses, because he was tempted as we are, yet did not sin.

Our Savior lived a perfect life, yet He also knew the pains of a broken world. He endured sorrow; He suffered agony and death. Jesus stands ready to encourage us through both the welcome and unwelcome changes of life. May the Lord guide us in our desert of grief and provide us with an oasis of hope in our new normal.
