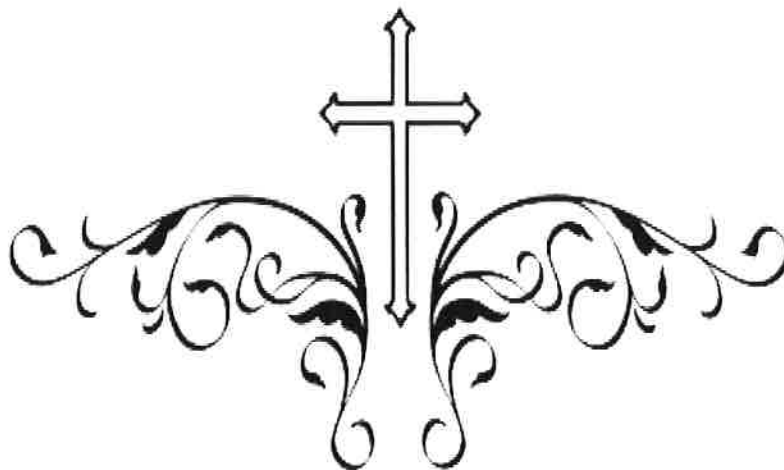
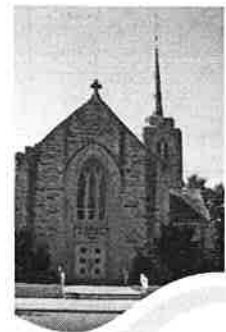

## Are you satisfied?

I was reading about an old Chinese greeting. Instead of "How are you?" people would ask "Have you eaten until you are full?" The greeting originated during a time when food was scarce and many people did not know when they would have their next meal.
