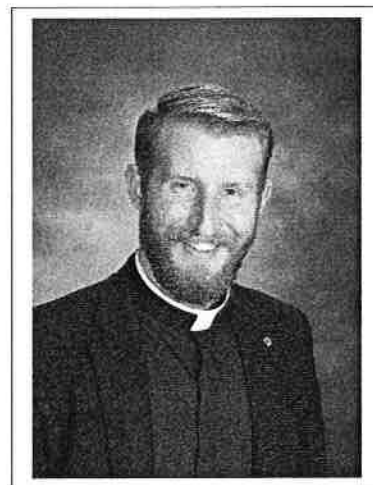
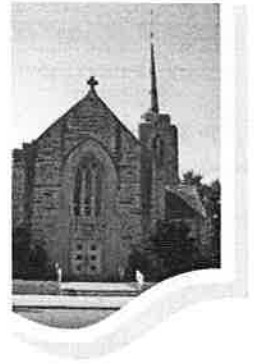

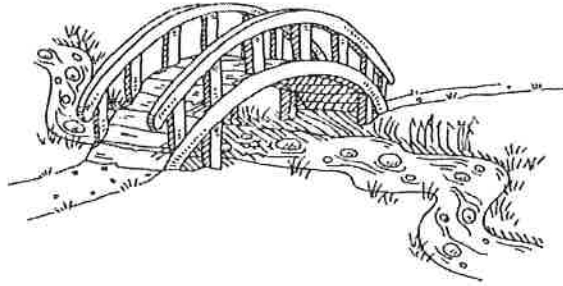

## Deception is nothing new!

In 2010, executives of a global banking firm deceived their customers about the risk involved in certain investments they were selling. While promising a high rate of return, the banking firm knew that the investments were destined to fail, leaving those who purchased them with nothing.

Deception is nothing new! Jesus described Satan as one who "does not stand in truth, because there is no truth in him... because he is a liar and the father of lies" (John 8:44). Satan tells us to 'live only for the present', when he knows it will result in our eternal loss.


Jesus, on the other hand, did not offer His disciples a life of prosperity and ease but called them to self-sacrifice and identify with Him. After telling them that He would be killed and raised from the dead, Jesus said, "If anyone wishes to come after me, he must deny himself and take up his cross daily and follow me. For whoever wishes to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for my sake will save it" (Luke 9: 23-24).

There are two voices telling us where to invest our lives. If we hold on to God's truth, we won't be trapped by Satan's lies.

Deception is nothing new, but to follow the wrong voice, is risky indeed!
